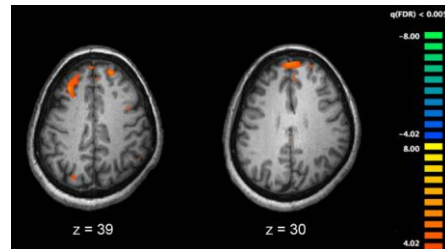
### Peace of Minds Walk 2017

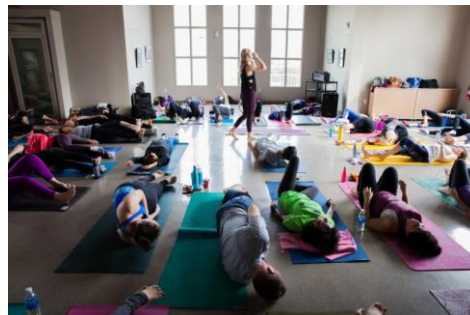
